From Northwest of Dayton, take Salem Ave toward downtown to Edwin C Moses Blvd, Right onto Edwin C Moses Blvd, right onto Germantown St, slight right onto Norwood Ave., Right onto Mound St, Left onto w 5th Street. Arrive 907 W 5th St, Dayton, OH 45402
